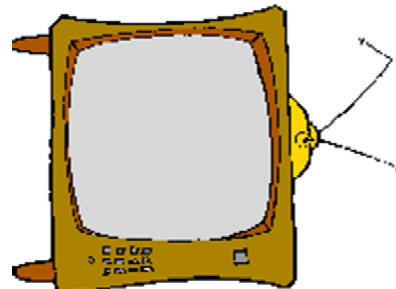
If anyone is interested, the New England Patriots are playing the NY Giants at UMass Alumni Stadium in Amherst on Thursday, July 27 for an exhibition game.

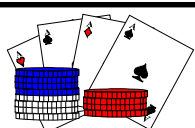
